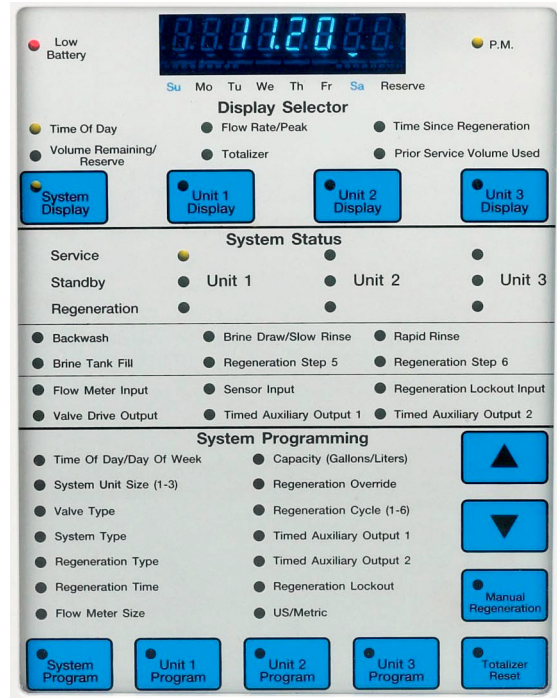
Systemax Obsolescence

Effective December 31st, 2006 as inventory depletes, the Systemax 2000 and 2014 systems will become obsolete. The Systemax systems are becoming obsolete due to declining customer demand since the rollout of the 3200NT and the 3200NT System 14.

The 3200NT controller can be used for system types 4, 5, 6, 7, and 9. In system types 5, 6, and 9 the 3200NT can control up to 4 valves in a system, compared to 3 valves by the Systemax 2000. The 3200NT also allows for the option to remotely mount the timer (please refer to Performance Bulletin #551 for additional information).


The 3200NT System 14 (a demand flow timer that brings control valves off and on-line based on flow demand) can control up to 4 valves in a system. The Systemax 2014 had a limit of 3 valves controlled in a system.

We will carry repair parts for the Systemax for 5 years or until repair parts are no longer available (whichever comes first).
